Global Seminars Refresher

What is it?

- Summer session global experiences led by a UCSD professor. Students enroll in a package of two courses for a total of 8 UCSD quarter units and 15-28 students per class. Approximately 27 Programs (varies every year)

When?

- Summer only

Budget?

- Budgets include almost everything including program fees, UCSD summer tuition and fees, housing, airfare, etc.. Personal expenses are not included

Financial Aid?

- Supplemental Summer Grant is available of approximately \$2,300 for eligible students with financial need and a minimum of 6 units. Summer Pell Grant & unused Federal Loans from the academic year will be offered

Billing?

- Administered by UCSD. Student makes payments and receives disbursements through UCSD

Global Seminar Budgets



Bucket 1: UCSD Summer Session Tuition & Fees

~ \$2,508. For the most up to date information, please visit the [UCSD Summer Session Website](#).



Bucket 2: Global Seminar Fees

~4.5k - 7.5k. [Housing, Classroom Rentals, Excursions, On-site staff, Administration, Insurance, etc.](#)



Bucket 3: Outside Costs

~ 3k - 4k. Plane tickets, Food, Passport, VISA, Books/Supplies, etc.

Bucket 1 + Bucket 2 = Your Mandatory Fees (your GS bill)

GS Budget Example

Revelle in London

Total Estimated Program Budget = \$12,311

- Bucket 1: UCSD Summer Tuition & Fees = ~\$2,508
- Bucket 2: GS Program Fees = ~\$6,426
- Bucket 3: Outside Costs = ~\$3,377

Total Due to UCSD (Bucket 1 & 2) = \$8,934

Total Other Costs (Bucket 3) = \$3,377

Summer Financial Aid & Scholarships Basics

What is available?

- **Supplemental Summer UCSD Grant** - Approximately \$2,300 for eligible students who are CA residents with financial need and a minimum of 6 units (Subject to annual review of funding)
- **Summer Pell Grant** - For students who have received Pell during prior academic year and have not exceeded their lifetime eligibility.
- **Unused Federal Loans (Subsidized & Unsubsidized)**- From the prior academic year will be offered
- **Scholarships**
- **Cal Vet Fee Waiver** - If eligible, will cover the UC Tuition/Fees portion of the GS program.

Billing:

- Administered by UCSD. Students make payments and receive disbursements through UCSD.

Non-Residents:

- No non-resident fees for summer!

Global Seminars Timeline

Student Process

1. Submit your GS application before the March 1st deadline

2. Apply to study abroad scholarships (most summer deadlines are in February/March)

3. If accepted to the program, email FAO-EAP@ucsd.edu to request an appointment for a FA estimate

4. Enroll in your GS courses (GS team will send instructions when time comes)

Financial Aid Process

5. ~6-8 weeks before program start date; FA office will receive official list of GS participants to package

6. ~4 weeks before program start date; FA office will begin packaging GS students to reflect program COA

7. If due for refund, disbursements will be according to the [UCSD summer session disbursement dates](#)

8. Enjoy your time Abroad!! Email FAO-EAP@ucsd.edu for any FA questions while abroad

Summer GS Payment Deadlines & Disbursements

Summer Session 1 GS Programs

- **Payment Deadline:** ~ last week of June
- **Disbursement:** Aid will be credited beginning approximately ~10 days before the first day of instruction (July 1, 2024).

Summer Session 2 GS Programs

- **Payment Deadline:** ~ late July - early August
- **Disbursement:** Aid will be credited beginning approximately ~10 days before the first day of instruction (August 5, 2024).

Special Session GS Programs (Sixth College Internships in Dublin)

- **Payment Deadline:** ~ last week of June (same as SS1)
- **Disbursement:** Aid will be credited approximately ~2 days before official Special Session GS Start Date (July 1, 2024).

Global Seminar + Other UCSD Summer Session

If planning to enroll in a Global Seminar session + another UCSD Summer Session, your aid will be credited in halves ($\frac{1}{2}$)

GS 2024 Program: People, Politics, and Power in Puerto Rico

Program Dates: July 1, 2025 - August 2, 2024

- UCSD Summer Session 1

Student decides to enroll in UCSD Summer Session 2 courses to take upon return from GS Summer Session 1 program

Units: The total number of summer units will increase (8 GS units + SS2 units)

- If Pell eligible, student can potentially receive more in Pell Grant since enrollment status will increase from half-time status.

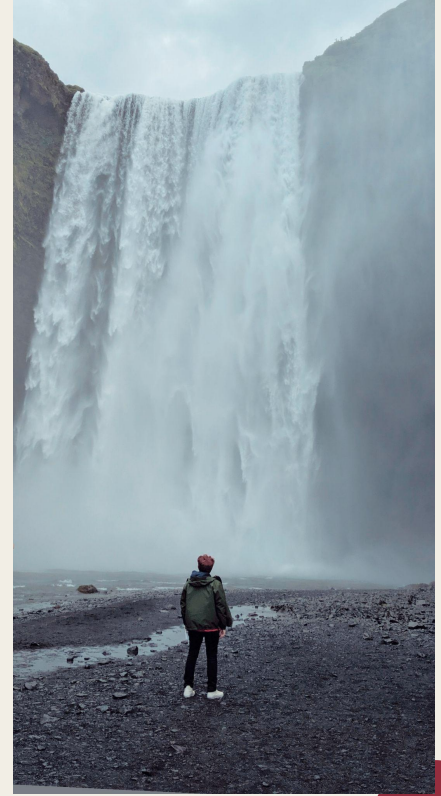
Payment Deadlines:

- GS Summer Session 1: ~ Due last week of June
- UCSD Summer Session 2: ~ Due late July - early August

Disbursements:

- Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of your summer aid will be credited approximately ~10 days before the first day of Summer Session 1 GS instruction (July 1, 2024). Other half ($\frac{1}{2}$) will be credited approximately ~10 days before the first day of Summer Session 2 UCSD instruction (August 5, 2024).

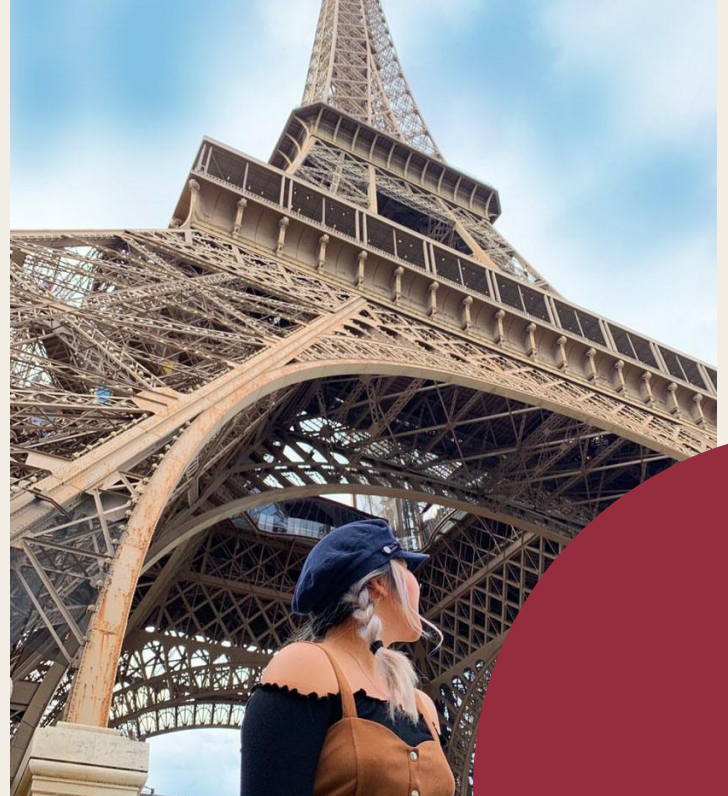

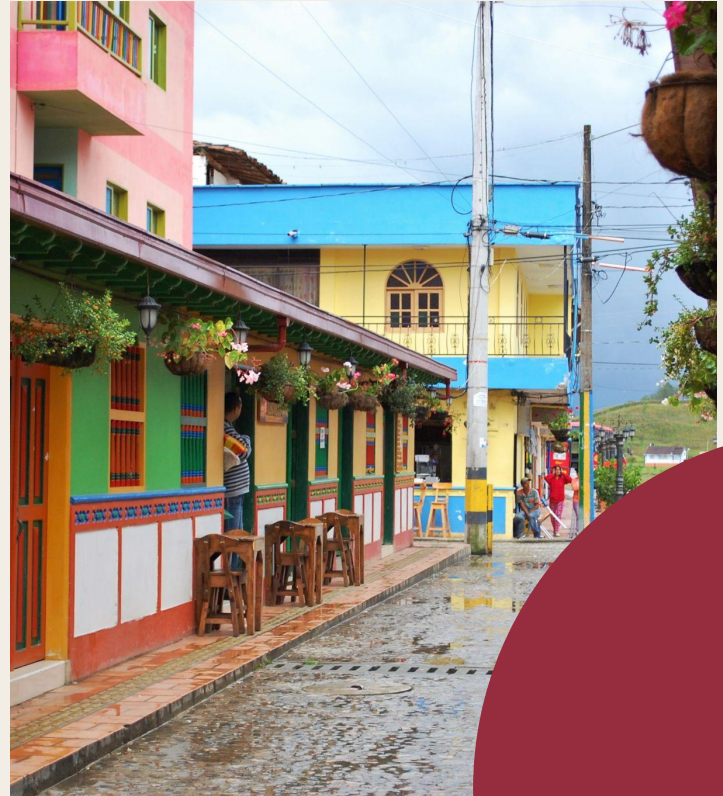
Chancellor's Study Abroad Scholarship

OASIS & DENNO Scholarships

OASIS GS Scholarship

Eligibility: 3.0 minimum GPA.

Any student enrolled in any of the following OASIS transition programs are eligible to apply:

- Summer Bridge
- 2Excel
- TRiO/SSSP
- Hope Scholars
- Transfer-to-Career
- Underground Scholars Initiative

Amount: Up to \$2,500 (~ Approximately 20 awards annually)

Kathleen Denno Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Must have demonstrated financial need

Gilman Scholarship

Purpose: Sponsored by the US Dept. Of State, undergraduate program for US citizens of limited financial means to enable them to study abroad and prepare them to thrive in the global economy.

Award Amount: Up to \$5,000 (\$3,000 for Summer Programs)

Number of Awards: 2,800+ nationally (Approx. 40-60 UCSD recipients annually)

Eligibility:

- Demonstrated Financial Need
- Must be a Pell Grant recipient at time of application or during study abroad
- U.S. Citizen

Where to apply: Gilman Website - <https://www.gilmanscholarship.org/>

Application deadline: **March 7, 2024** (Summer 2024 - Spring 2025 programs)



Reminders / Withdrawal Deadline

Reminders:

- There is no separate application for Summer Financial Aid. For summer 2024 programs, we will be using your current 2023-2024 FAFSA we have on file.
- Ensure your financial aid account is up to date with no outstanding documents needed.
- Apply to your GS courses! GS team will send instructions once summer enrollment is open.
- Apply for Study Abroad Scholarship beginning in January!!!

GS WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: MARCH 1, 2024

- **Withdrawing after March 1st can result in owing the GS Program Fee (2K - 5k).**
